1962, **ADIEU PHILIPPINE** is on the cover of Les Cahiers du cinéma with the headline : "NOUVELLE VAGUE". Jacques Rozier's first feature screened at Critics' Week in Cannes. It was preceded by an overly flattering introduction by Jean-Luc Godard who declared it "quite simply the best French film of recent years". Jacques Rozier's work captured the spirit of the younger generation in France in the late 1950s and early 60s, perhaps more successfully than any of his contemporaries. His work was quintessentially New Wave: freewheeling, naturalistic and spontaneous.




