ARTURO RIPSTEIN - DIRECTOR

Born December 13th, 1943 in Mexico City, Mexico. Began his career as assistant director of Luis Buñuel in *El Ángel Exterminador* (1962). His father, Alfredo Ripstein, Jr. produced his first film, a western written by Gabriel García Márquez titled *Tiempo de morir* (*Time to Die*, 1965).

Arturo Ripstein's filmography is very praised in Mexico and Europe. He is considered the best Mexican director alive. Many of his films are related with a unique subject: the loneliness of souls.
